TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

Tentative Schedule: Numbers of rounds and timings may be changed according to numbers of participants.

System of Play: The tournament will be conducted as per fide laws of chess & Fide Swiss system.

Age Proof: Each participant must produce a valid certificate to prove his/her age. Certificates from School will not be accepted. Certificates should preferably be from the Panchayat, Municipality or Corporation obtained soon after birth. Players without date of birth certificates will not be allowed to participate. The date of birth certificates registered within one year of the birth of the player alone will be recognized and allowed to participate.

Age Limit: Players should be born on or after 2014(Under-11),2012(Under-13)

System Of Play: The tournament will be conducted as per fide laws of chess & Fide Swiss system.

Tie Break: Latest Tie-break rules will be followed.

Time Control: 30 minutes each with increment of 30 seconds from move number one.

Default Time: Default time will be 15 minutes.

Protest: Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a Protest fee of Rs. 1000/- within 30 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded, if the appeal is upheld.

Disqualification: No participant will leave the venue before the Prize distribution function without the permission of the Chief Arbiter. The participants disregarding the rule will be suspended for one year.

Appeals Committee: Before the commencement of the championship, a five-member Appeals Committee shall be formed by the organisers. All the members and reserves shall be from the different units. No member of the committee can vote on a dispute in which a player from his own district is involved and in such case the reserves shall take his place in the committee.

Interpretation: On any point not covered under these rules, the decision of the Championship Committee shall be final and binding on all. The Championship Committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, without prior notice. However, such changes will be approved by the MP Chess Ad-hoc Committee. Such changes will, however, be displayed in the tournament hall.

Electronic Devices: All electronic items including wrist watches (all type of watches) are not allowed in the tournament hall.

Disqualification: No participant will leave the tournament venue before the prize distribution function without the permission of the Chief Arbiter otherwise, his/her prize and certificate will be forfeited, and disciplinary action will be taken.
